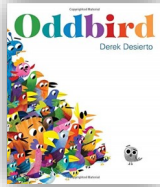


Bullies & Bullying

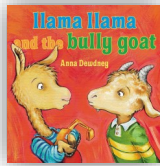
Here is a list of our favorite books to learn about bullying! These titles can all be found in the EASY section of the library, unless otherwise noted!

E DESI

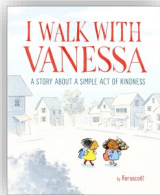

E DEWD

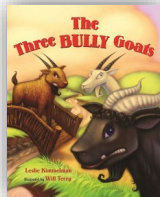
Following their teacher's lead, Llama Llama speaks to Gilroy Goat and tells him he should not act like a bully on the playground.

E KERA

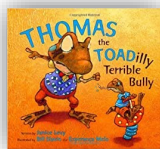
An elementary school girl witnesses the bullying of another girl, but she is not sure how to help.

E LEVY

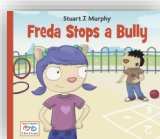
After feeling ignored in his new town, a young toad tries to act like a bully but learns the value of being a good friend instead.

E LYNC

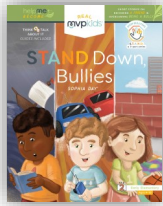
Marlene is the class bully until Big Freddy stands up to her.

E MURP

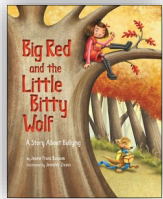
Max makes fun of Freda's shoes, but Freda soon learns how to cope with his bullying.

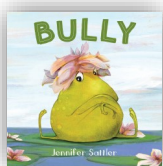
Even a good kid can struggle with being a bully. Find out what Ezekiel, Sarah and Blake do when they realize their actions are hurting others.

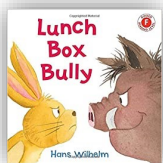
When a selfish bullfrog takes over a lily pond, the other residents decide to unite and take action.

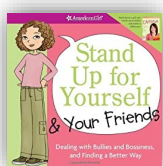
A little bull discovers that he has been a big bully.

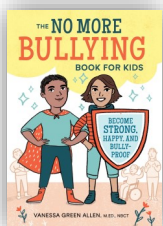
Max outwits a bully and makes a new friend.

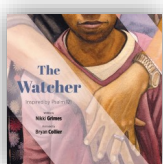
