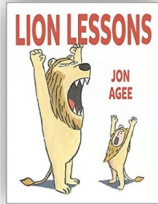


Great Read-Alouds

E AGEE

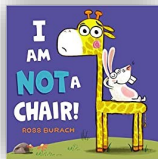
Learning to be a lion takes some serious lessons, but luckily, this kid has a teacher who is a real pro.

E BERN

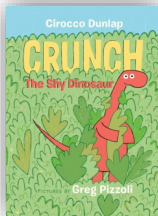
A fearless little girl takes off in search of a giant gator--but she's not going into that swamp alone! No way!

E DUNL

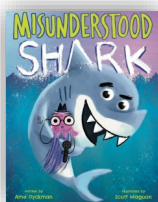
Advises the reader on how to interact with a very shy dinosaur.

E CLAN

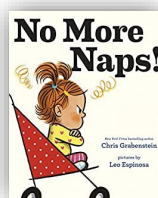
After Liam writes to his mailbox, asking for more mail, he gets his wish, but soon he realizes that sending mail is even more fun than receiving it.

E HIGG

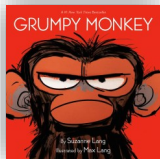
Rupert the mouse wants to star in an artistic, wordless picture book, but his animal friends cause problems by talking too much.

E JOHN

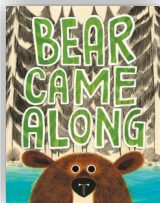
A penguin whines about the uncontrollable problems in his life.

E MORR

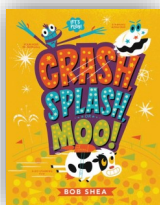
Bear is on a big adventure. But he doesn't know how big until his friends join in. Maybe the most important lesson of all--that they're in it together.

E REYN

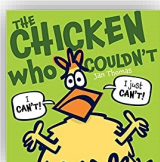
Using just the one word, "dude," this almost wordless picture book shows how much gnarly fun the dudes have surfing

E SHEA

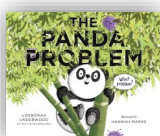
Mr. McMonkey hosts a game in which the reader is invited to guess whether a stunt will result in a crash, a splash, or a moo.
